A to B: 0.5 miles, 0 min

- 1. Depart Mormon Bridge Rd0.5 miles
- 2. Arrive at 7909 Mormon Bridge Rd, Omaha, NE 68152-24130.0 miles
If you reach Raven Oaks Dr, you've gone too far

B to C: 18.8 miles, 26 min

- 1. Depart Mormon Bridge Rd0.0 miles
- 2. Bear right onto Sheffield St0.1 miles
- 3. Road name changes to N 54th Ave0.1 miles
- 4. Road name changes to King St0.3 miles
- 5. Turn right onto N 60th St0.2 miles
- 6. Turn left onto State St1.0 miles
- 7. Turn right onto N 72nd St0.5 miles
- 8. Take ramp left for I-680 South9.4 miles
- 9. At exit 446, take ramp left for I-80 East toward Downtown2.3 miles
- 10. At exit 448, take ramp right & follow signs for 84th Street0.3 miles
- 11. Turn right onto S 84th St4.2 miles
Pass CHEVROLET in 0.6 mi
- 12. Turn right onto W 6th St0.1 miles
- 13. Arrive at 233 W 6th St, Papillion, NE 68046-22100.0 miles
*The last intersection is N Adams St.
If you reach N Jackson St, you've gone too far*
