## Mid-America Hike 2011

Dear Bethel Guardian,

Enclosed is the information for the 23rd Annual Mid-America Hike to be held on May 7, 2011 at Clinton Lake, Lawrence, Kansas 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Registration begins at 11:00 a.m. and walk starts at 11:30 a.m. followed by lunch. A lunch will be provided for a \$5.00 donation to HIKE. Directions to Clinton Lake are attached.

### **BEFORE THE WALK**

1. Distribute the Sponsor Forms to each walker. The walker can be a Job's Daughter, parent, guardian, council member, friend, hearing impaired person etc. Make additional copies of forms as necessary.
2. Have the walkers collect their donations prior to the walk and bring donations on Saturday May 7th. Convert all CASH to CHECKS. Make checks payable to HIKE FUND, INC. and mark memo for Mid-America Hike.
3. Ask your mayor, city council or county board to issue a proclamation. This seeks their backing for the project and tells the community of your effort.
4. Contact your local news media: Tell them about the proclamation, the Mid-America Walk and your participation.
5. Get a count of how many will be coming for the lunch and call Renee Saylor or e-mail [mom4scr@sunflower.com](mailto:mom4scr@sunflower.com) by April 29.

### **THE DAY OF THE WALK**

1. Make sure each walker brings her/his Sponsor Sheet and money donated to the walk. They need to be turned in to receive awards.
2. Meet at Clinton Lake, Shelter #2 for registration which starts at 11:00 a.m.
3. Have each walker turn in donation money to you or someone from your Bethel. Prepare a Summary/Incentive Order Form for your whole Bethel and turn it in to your state representative at the Hike table. It is very important that you turn in your contributions by Bethel since the SG Incentives awards will be mailed.
4. Have a lot of fun meeting new people, enjoy the scenery and stay for lunch and awards.

### **AFTER WALK**

1. Stay for lunch, awards and volleyball.
2. Make sure your state coordinator receives any late donations.

## **Directions**

From I-70, exit 197 (Lecompton Interchange), then take the K-10 Bypass East. This is traveling in a southerly direction.

Go approximately 4 miles until you see the Clinton Lake (Clinton Parkway) exit.

Turn right(west) on Clinton Parkway and drive less than one-quarter mile and you are at a STOP sign.

This is a "T" intersection. Turning left will take you across the Clinton Dam. You need to turn right (north) on 900E road.

Take the first left (west) into the Overlook Park.

There will be a stone and wood "Clinton Lake U.S. Army Corps of Engineers" sign at this intersection. This road travels past the Corps of Engineers Project Office/Information Center/Visitor Center. This is a brick building with a green metal roof and a flagpole in front.

You will soon enter the Overlook Park. There will be a vault toilet restroom on your right hand side (west side) and soon after that you will make a right turn into a parking lot and will see shelter #2 at that point.
