Dear Bethel Guardian,

Enclosed is information on the Missouri Job's Daughters Grand Guardian Council scholarships. Please read this information at your next Bethel meeting. There will be several scholarships awarded to qualified Daughters at Grand Session in June 2010.

It is the Daughter's responsibility to have the form completed and given to her Executive Bethel Guardian Council (EBGC) in sufficient time for them to write a letter of recommendation and meet the **required postmark deadline of April 1**. It is the obligation of the EBGC to prepare a letter of recommendation. Three members of the EBGC (with their titles included) **must sign the letter** of recommendation. The letter should explain why the Council members believe the Daughter is qualified to receive a scholarship and detail the contributions the Daughter has made to her Bethel. If there are any special circumstances that will help the committee in the selection process, please feel free to add this to the letter. There must be **THREE COPIES** of the application and letter sent to me at my address:

We do not wish to eliminate a Daughter's application simply because her EBGC did not properly complete its portion of the application process. **Please do not jeopardize one of your Daughter's chances for a scholarship**. If for some reason you cannot obtain the proper number of signature, please contact me or the Grand Guardian for further assistance.

Please provide the application and cover letter to all eligible Daughters of your Bethel so they will know how to complete the application and may apply before the **deadline of April 1, 2010**. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered for a scholarship.

Daughters who have previously been awarded this scholarship are allowed to apply for a second time. If there are funds available after all first time recipients have received a scholarship, then the previous scholarship winners will be eligible for an additional scholarship.

Dear Bethel Daughters,

Scholarships will be awarded this year to the Daughters of Missouri Bethels who have been active for at least one year, or majority members who are not over the age of 25 years. Scholarships will vary in amounts. Past recipients of scholarships are eligible to reapply, the first time applicants will be awarded first consideration and if funds are available, past recipients will be considered. All forms, letters and signatures required below are needed in order to be eligible for consideration. **Failure to submit all required documents will result in disqualification for a scholarship.**

The basis for selections will be:

1. Daughter's contributions to her Bethel and community,
2. scholastic standing in high school or college,
3. recommendations from the Executive Bethel Guardian Council, and
4. responses submitted to the questions on the application.

Daughters must answer the questions provided on the enclosed "Scholarship Application Instructions" sheet. Additional sheets may be used for the answers. **The applicant and her parent or legal guardian must sign and date the bottom of the application sheet. A letter of recommendation signed by three Executive Bethel Guardian Council members with their titles must be submitted as well.**

Please be sure the answers are legible and that each question is answered as completely as possible. There must be **THREE COPIES** of everything submitted. Please do not wait until the last minute to begin to work on your application. Let your Bethel Guardian know of your interest in applying so she can begin working with the Executive Bethel Guardian Council members on the letter of recommendation. All applications must be **postmarked by April 1, 2010**. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered for a scholarship.

All Daughters are eligible to apply for a loan to continue their education, including scholarship winners. Loans to any one applicant shall not exceed \$300.00. To assist the Scholarship Committee in scoring, answers need to be as complete and thorough as possible. Do not leave any question blank, as this will result in a zero score for that area. Return **THREE COPIES** of the completed and signed application sheet, answer sheets and Executive Bethel Guardian Council's recommendation letter **postmarked no later than April 1, 2010 to:**

1. State how long you have been in Job's Daughters and list the offices you have held in your Bethel. Explain how you have contributed to your Bethel.
2. List all honors you have received in Job's Daughters. Include any received in your Bethel (Spirit Award, Membership Medallion, etc.); include any received as a result of being chosen by your Bethel to represent them (Miss MO, Scottish Rite Youth Ball, etc.); also include any offices held with SLALOC or KCJD Line Officers Club. Do not include DeMolay Sweetheart, etc.
3. List any ways that you have served Grand Bethel – list offices held and committees served.
4. List individual awards received in competition at Grand Session: i.e. ritual, arts/crafts, music solo, group or ensemble awards.
5. List and describe the high school activities (and college if applicable) in which you have been involved and the number of years you participated.
6. List and describe the church activities in which you have been involved and the number of years you participated.
7. List and describe the community activities and volunteer work you have done including the number of years you participated.
8. List and describe any other organizations in which you are involved and include employment experience.
9. Describe how Job's Daughters has helped you develop leadership abilities and explain how it relates to your every day life.
10. Describe in what ways Job's Daughters has helped you grow as an individual.
